The British government's Renewable Transport Fuel Obligation requires 5% of the fuel sold at the pump by 2010 to be biofuel. Some businesses are now switching to biodiesel or bioethanol in order to reduce carbon emissions.

There are also cost implications to businesses. In a volatile market, global oil is now at an all time high and cars above a certain engine size will be required to pay more tax. Lack of action now will increasingly affect both the productivity and profitability of inefficient businesses in the future.
